FREE STATE STRATEGY SESSION

The National Development Agency (NDA) Free State provincial office hosted stakeholders to an engagement session to outline service delivery plans that will be implemented in the 2022/23 financial year. Stakeholders in attendance included the South African Social Security Agency (SASSA), National Lotteries Commission, Department of Social Development, Setshabelo Family and Child Services, Hope World Wide, Small Enterprise Development Agency (SEDA) and Department of Economic, Small Business Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs to engage and forge partnerships on areas of collaboration.

A representative from the Lejweleputswa District Municipality presented a draft of the District Development Model (DDM). The NDA Free State provincial office will deliver its DDM services within the Lejweleputswa district which comprises of Nala, Matjabeng, Tswelopele, Tokologo and Masilonyana municipalities. Internal support functions within the NDA also lent support to the session, to present service support and forge ways to strengthen operational relations – DMR and Marketing and Communications.

The provincial staff also reviewed their 2021/22 performance on their setout development programmes (including CARA, Volunteer Programme, Grant Funding and Monitoring) and proceeded to dissect and plan for the 2022/23 financial year for their targeted deliverables. The team is in good spirits and have jointly pledged to, through learnt lessons from last year, deliver a more effective and impactful development programme in this new financial year.
